New Chapter Begins at Alpha II, Inc.

At a special meeting of the Board of Directors of Alpha II, Inc. on September 22, the board accepted the resignation of Chief Executive Officer, Glenn Scott effective September 30, 2008. "Glenn has given two years of outstanding service to this organization. He has been a great asset to Alpha II, Inc. and will be greatly missed" said Jason Johnson, Board President. Mr. Scott has accepted the Chief Financial Officer position at Cool Rush, Inc., in Blackwell.

During Mr. Scott's tenure at Alpha II, Inc., the organization reached unprecedented heights. Highlights include achieving CARF Accreditation twice, increased State Funding to the facility and removed Department of Corrections inmates from the facility. In addition to CARF accreditation and Department of Corrections program elimination, the organization now leads the state in nearly every measurable area of treatment efficiencies. Additionally, under Mr. Scott's leadership, donations to the organization have continued to climb, with non-cash donations doubling, and the largest cash donation to the organization to date. The organization has also been chosen as a beneficiary of the United Way in 2009. Finally, Mr. Scott was the driving force responsible for forming the A2 Foundation, where he serves as President, to help provide financial assistance to the organization in the form of treatment scholarships and capital fundraising.

Also, at the special meeting the Board of Directors unanimously passed a resolution to continue towards the Strategic Plan developed by Mr. Scott which includes the current fundraising campaign and 30th Anniversary Dinner scheduled for November 15th at the Renfro Center on the Northern Oklahoma Campus. According to Mr. Johnson, "We feel that the organization has been left in a position to continue along the path outlined for us by Mr. Scott".

He concluded by saying, “the organization is going in an exciting direction and will continue to grow and succeed.” The Board of Directors thanked Mr. Scott for his knowledge and hard work over the past few years and wishes him the best of luck in the future.
