Alpha II, Inc. Cancels Department of Corrections Contract

Alpha II, Inc. announces that effective March 1, 2008 the organization will no longer house Department of Corrections inmates. The organization provided the Department of Corrections notice of cancellation during the month of February and inmates began transferring from the facility almost immediately.

“This is an exciting change”, said Glenn Scott, CEO, “this will allow us to operate our facility in a manner more consistent with our mission statement”.

This change will allow the facility to immediately begin to reconfigure its programs and facilities to allow for a much larger capacity to serve substance abuses clients. Over time this reconfiguration will allow the organization to serve as many as 50 individuals at one time.
